What is PARCC?

<u>Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Career.</u>

This is the organization that is crafting the new Common Core aligned assessments.

When will we see PARCC assessments?

PARCC assessments are slated for implementation in the 2014-15 school year and will be computer based.

Two summative, required assessments at the end of the school year. (PBA - Performance Based Assessment & EOY - End of Year Assessment)

Two non-summative, *optional* assessments at beginning and middle of the school year may be available in 2015-2016

When will we see PARCC assessments?

PARCC Tests are being developed for <u>all students</u> who take: ***CHANGE***

FR English - PBA & EOY in Spring 2015

Algebra 1 - PBA & EOY in Spring 2015

SO English - scheduled for Spring 2016 pending state funds

Geometry - scheduled for Spring 2016 pending state funds

JR English - scheduled for Spring 2016 pending state funds

Algebra 2 - scheduled for Spring 2016 pending state funds

How does this fit with ACT?

ACT is still preferred by colleges for their admission process

In 2015, IL will provide the ACT & Workkeys to districts & JR students at no charge.

In the future, students will likely have to take the ACT on a National Testing Day (Saturday). Waivers will be available for students from low-income families.
