## Cell Phone and Electronic Device Policy

The use of communication devices, such as cell phone, and other electronic devices during the school day or on school buses unless in an emergency is not allowed. Other devices that may not be used include, but are not limited to the use of an iPod, CD player or handheld game, use of a camera cell phone or PDA camera to invade privacy. Use of these devices violates the code of conduct and Centennial School Policies.

Students may bring cell phones to school but they can't be used at school, must be kept in their backpack and must be secured in their cubby/locker during the entire school day
