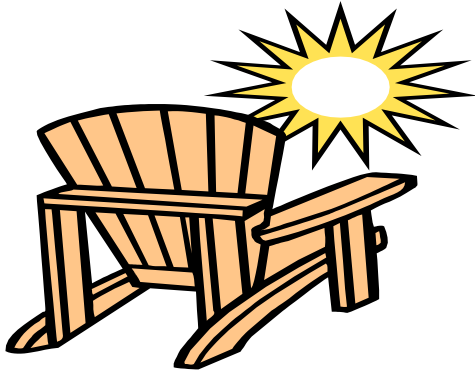

Reminders from the Nurse

ATTENTION: NEW STATE REQUIREMENTS

All Centennial students are required to have 2 (two) MMR vaccines. Students entering Kindergarten and 6th grade need 2 (two) Varicella (chicken pox) vaccines for the 2014-2015 school year and a Health Physical. Students will **NOT** be allowed into school without proof of these vaccines.

Incoming 6th graders will need proof of Tdap vaccine along with their Health Physicals to begin the 2014-2015 school

year. It is a District Policy to EXCLUDE students without these vaccines. If you have any questions, here is the link to the District.
