Happenings at Centennial

PARCC testing will begin April 4-29th for our 3rd-6th grade students. This is the yearly assessment mandated by the State of Illinois. The PARCC assessments serve as an "educational GPS system," assessing students' current performance, and pointing the way to what students need to learn to be ready for the next grade level and, by high school graduation, for college and/or a career. The PARCC assessments are designed to give schools and teachers more information to improve instruction. Moreover, PARCC is designed to let parents know how their child is progressing academically. This more detailed information can lead to strong engagement between parents and teachers. Please help them do their best by having a great breakfast each morning and getting lots of rest.

Map testing will be in May for 2nd-6th graders.

We will be holding another Typing Class for 3rd-6th graders from April 4th-May 5th. Classes will be Mondays and Thursdays after school. Look for permission slips coming home soon. This is a great opportunity for students to practice their typing skills for the assessments they are taking.

Attention 5th graders: Take advantage of spring break and get those physicals done. They are required for 6th grade.

Our Health office is in need of clothes for K-3rd. We are looking for pants, sweats, socks and shirts. Just a few for when students play at recess and get wet or muddy.
