Enterovirus D68

The Enterovirus D68 has been making children and teenagers, especially those with asthma sick this year. The symptoms may include fever, runny nose, sneezing, cough and muscle aches. Severe symptoms may include wheezing and difficulty breathing.

Centennial School will do everything we can to clean surfaces and other areas of the school. We will also be watching for symptoms of students in school.

Head Lice

It's that time of year when things that crawl and make our heads itch become a problem. We expect a few cases of lice every year. While certainly not an epidemic, a few extra steps on your part will help to reduce the spread. Because research has shown that mass screening is NOT effective, the Nurses no longer screen the entire classrooms. The best prevention is for you to examine your student's hair on a regular basis and to remind them to NOT share combs, hats, scrunchies, barrettes, etc. If you notice they are scratching their heads, please look for the cause. If they have lice, please treat them and let the Health Office know. If you need information on prevention and/or treatment, please call the Health Office. There are many web sites as well. Lice aren't lethal, just a nuisance. Thank you for helping us keep our students healthy.
