Cell Phone and Electronic Device Policy

Fun Fair

The use of communication devices, such as cell phone, and other electronic devices during the school day or on school buses unless in an emergency is not allowed. Other devices that may not be used include, but are not limited to the use of an iPod, CD player or hand-held game, use of a camera cell phone or PDA camera to invade privacy. Use of these devices violates the code of conduct and Centennial School Policies.

Students may bring cell phones to school but they can't be used at school, must be kept in their backpack and must be secured in their cubby/locker dur-

ing the entire school day and extended school activities. The cell phones will be allowed to be used only in an emergency. Cell phones must stay in the cubby in the student's backpack at ALL times.

We will confiscate electronic devices and hold the confiscated cell phone or electronic device in the main office until the parent or guardian picks them up at school office. In addition, the school will not be responsible for the loss of a cell phone or electronic device that a student brings to Centennial School.

Snow Removal

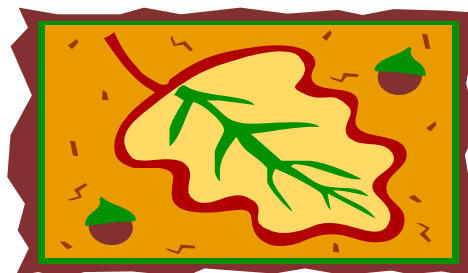
Major snow removal is done by Plant Operations from the District. Our custodian will clean the sidewalks as quickly as possible to make it safe for our staff and students.
