### Parking Rules

1. No Cell Phone Use is allowed in School Zone.
2. No stopping in driving lane to drop off student. NOT SAFE!
3. Drive Slowly through the parking lot.
4. Parents and Guardians should only park in designated areas. Do not park in Staff parking areas or Fire Lane.

### Bicycle Rules

Only students in 3rd-6th grade are allowed to ride bikes to school. A permission slip needs to be filled out in the Main Office.

Students need to agree to the following:

\*I agree to keep my bicycle parked in the proper place and locked during school hours. I understand that I am NOT to unlock my bike and ride it during any recess time.

\*When I arrive at school, I will dismount from my bicycle and walk it on the school grounds.
