*I agree to keep my bicycle parked in the proper place and locked during school hours. I understand that I am NOT to unlock my bike and ride it during any recess time.

*When I arrive at school, I will dismount from my bicycle and walk it on the school grounds.

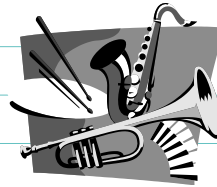
