Our Challenge

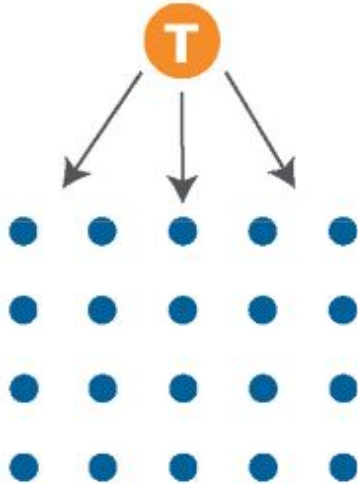

Equity, Our Collective Effort

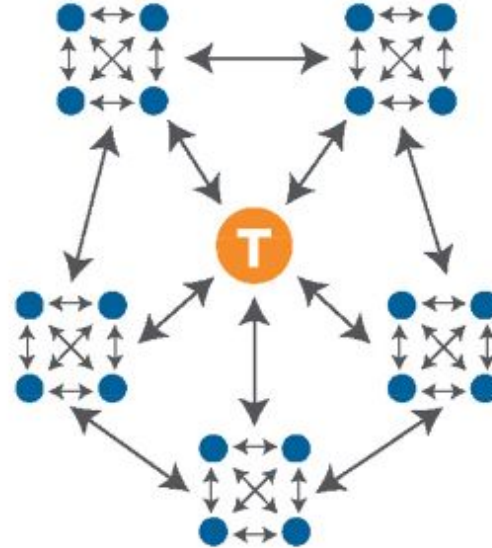
We will not locate deficits in **our** students, rather seek out deficits in our systems that generate **our** results. Each of **our** systems must be measured and improved.

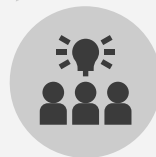

What is the learning target for the day, how is the target aligned to grade-level standards, and how does the student work align to the target?

Organizing Students to Achieve the Standard

Is the task one that requires teaming? Are there structures in place to ensure interdependency and promote productive struggle student agency?

Monitoring to Take Action Within the Lesson

How is feedback provided within the lesson both from the teacher as well as between students?

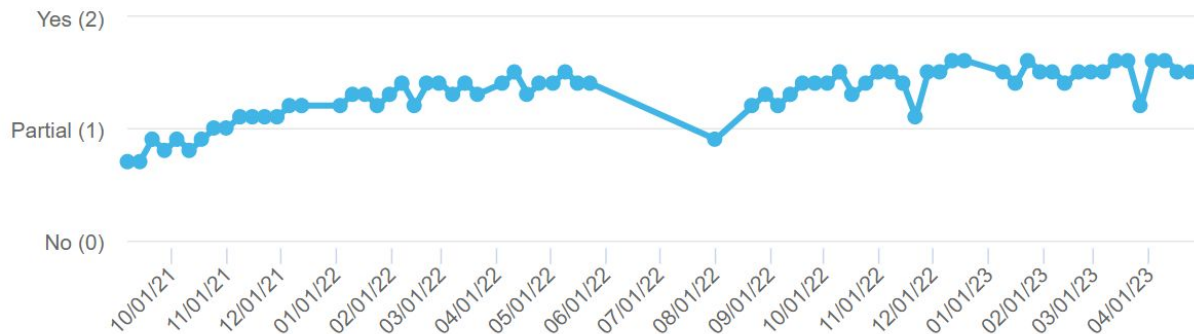

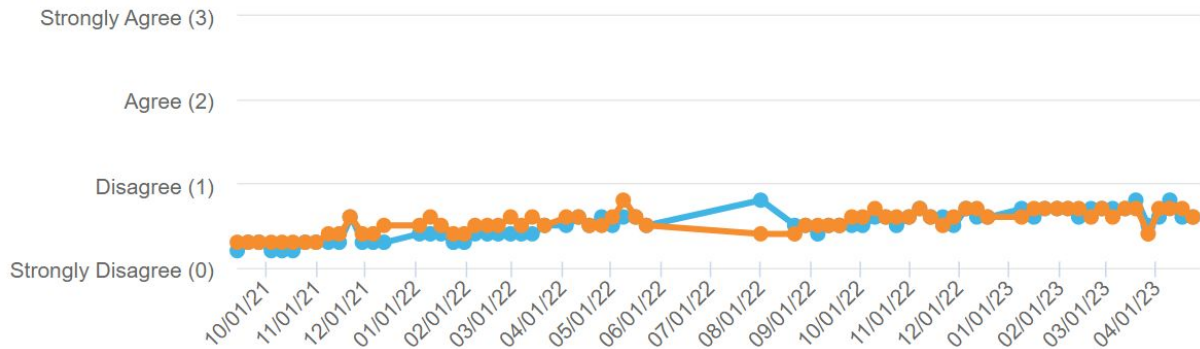
