- B. Curriculum/Resource Updates
 - 1. Early Learner Curriculum Proposal Pam Maxey

The Early Learner team came to present their PD plan around the updated units, new report card format, and incorporation of Learning Genie for all of the Pre-K and K teachers during the 23-24 SY. - 2. LHS Arts Magnet Revision Jaimie Giraldo
 - a) PD Proposal

The LHS Magnet academy will be rolling out new curriculum in the 24-25 school year. In order to support this, the team will have 1 full day of required PD for each area of the magnet academy during the 23-24 SY. The majority of teachers affected by the PD plan also help to write the new curriculum which means that they are aware of the requirement as well as the plan for adopting the new curriculum.
