Board's 'Accent on Achievement' program to recognize school counselors, students named All-State Musicians

ELGIN - Nine U-46 high school students will be recognized by the Board of Education Monday with an "Accent on Achievement" for their outstanding achievements as musicians. The Board of Education will also recognize the integral role of school counselors as part of National School Counseling Week, Feb. 4-9, 2019.

The American School Counselor Association's annual recognition highlights the impact school counselors can have in helping students achieve academic success and prepare for college and careers. School District U-46 added counselors to each middle school this year, restoring these important roles after they were lost during the recession a decade ago.
