ELGIN - The U-46 Board of Education will honor the South Elgin High School Co-Ed Varsity Cheer Team on Monday for being named champions at the Illinois High School Association (IHSA) Cheerleading State Finals. The Board will also recognize the vital role social workers play in schools as part of National School Social Work Week, March 1-7, 2020.

The School Social Work Association of America's annual recognition highlights how school social workers enhance the social and emotional growth and academic outcomes of all students, emphasizing the whole child and linking students and families with needed services. U-46 employs about 90 social workers across the District.

"Our social workers act as advocates, mediators, counselors, case managers, program developers. They help in times of need and prevent far more issues from becoming a crisis," said CEO Tony Sanders. "Social workers are vital partners in the important work we are doing every day in U-46."
