
Pre-K Classrooms at the High School




- Opened our first half-day preschool classrooms at Larkin High School.

- Full-time CTE teachers who work with high school students on childhood education pathway.










Options for Shift of 6th Grade to Middle School



- Option A: Postpone the shift until the 2027-2028 school year
- All 7200 students in grades 6-8 would remain in their currently assigned schools. 6th graders would stay in elementary.




New middle school on Rohrssen Road in Elgin scheduled to be ready for occupancy in August 2027.

Options for Shift of 6th Grade to Middle School



- Option B: Transition 6th grade to middle school over two years
- Approximately 50% of our 6th graders (1200 students) would attend middle school in 26-27




Ellis, Abbott to remain open serving grades 7, 8 in 2026-2027, then be retired in 2027-2028.

Options for Shift of 6th Grade to Middle School




- Option C: Transition all 6th grade to middle school in 2026-2027
- ~1100 students would be assigned to an alternate site for 26-27



New middle school in Elgin would open in 2027-2028 serving grades 6, 7, 8. Ellis, Abbott to be retired in 2027-2028.


Options for Shift of 6th Grade to Middle School



| | | Advantage | Disadvantage |
|---|--|--|--|
| 1 | Postpone shift until 2027-2028 when the new middle school will be ready for occupancy | Minimizes student transitions | Delays MS experience by one year for all U-46 students |
| 2 | Transition 6th grade students over two years: 2026-2027 - east side 2027-2028 - west side | Removes the risk of construction projects not being completed | Inconsistent 6th grade experience for U-46 students in year one |
| 3 | Transition all 6th grade students in 2026-2027 by keeping Ellis and Abbott open in a limited capacity | All 6th grade students will receive middle school experience | Additional transition for some of our students |


Unite U-46 Estimated Summary of Funding Sources


