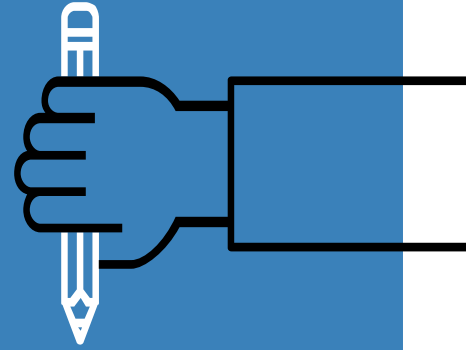


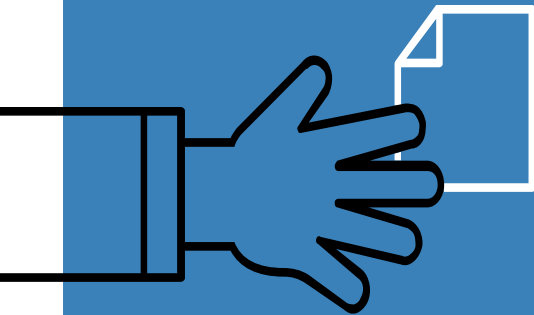

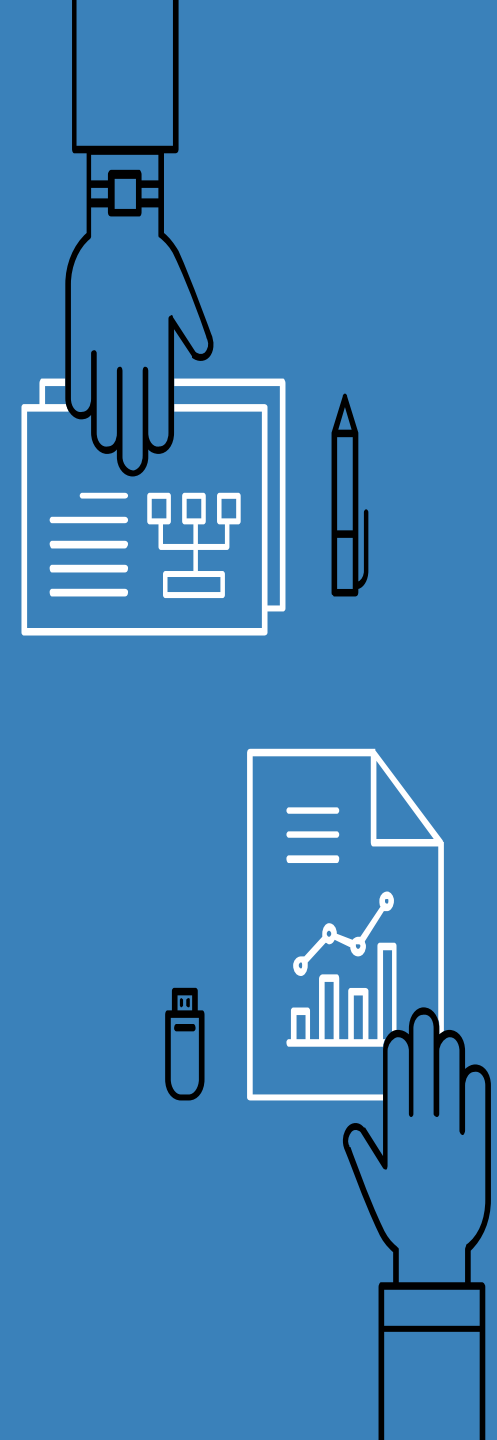

Student Summit

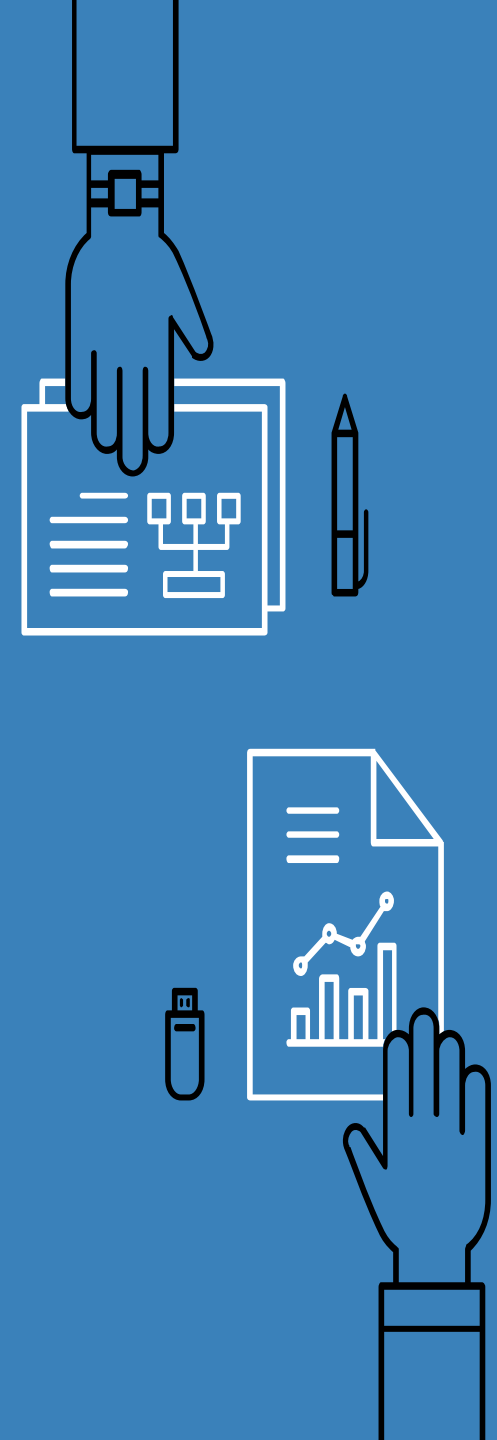
- February 27, 2019
- Over 200 students participated from all 6 high schools
- CEO Advisors facilitated table top conversations in three areas:
 - ◆ Academics
 - ◆ Mental Health
 - ◆ Miscellaneous



Academics

Based on feedback from all high schools, our biggest take-aways in the area of academics were:

- **SAT and ACT Preparation**
 - Student awareness of resources
 - Students would like an elective course or after school preparation
- **Life Skills**
 - Students would like these skills embedded into coursework, specifically around financial literacy, resume building, and interviews
 - Explore embedding social-emotional learning into study halls or courses
- **Career Clusters**
 - More awareness and communication for parents and students
- **Curriculum Consistency**

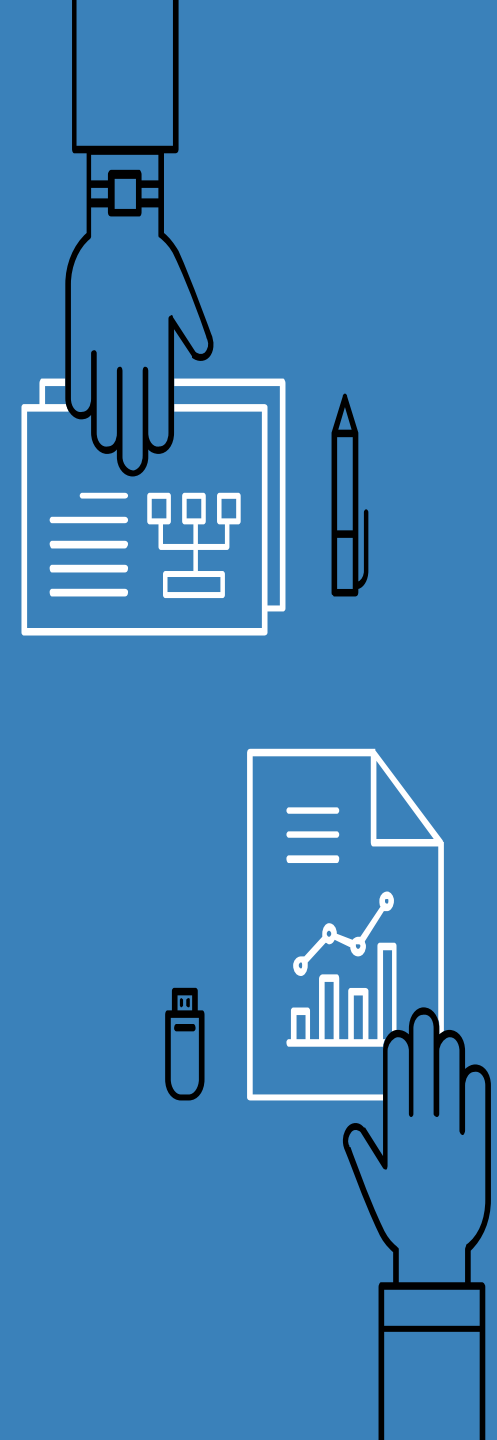


Mental Health

Based on feedback from all high schools, our biggest take-aways in the area of mental health were

→ Relationships

- Counselors, deans, and social workers assigned by last name and not by relationship
- Students are not aware of the support staff available
- Having Staff Who Resemble the Students
- Opportunities for Peer to Peer Assistance and Access to Mentors
- Staff Collaboration to Address Student Needs
- Intentional, Ongoing Visibility of Resources and Easier Access to Them



Miscellaneous

→ Course Selection

- Having a better understanding of what the content of courses before registration

→ Safety Procedures and Dress Code

- Consistency of implementation across schools
- Student and parent orientation of safety procedures throughout the school year
- Drills in the lunchroom or during transitions

→ Chromebooks

- Teacher training
- Creating a balance between technology and paper

→ Relationships

- Staff balancing instruction, relationships, and opportunities for students to engage in collaborative group work/problem-solving
