



Phase 1 Boundary Changes New Middle School at Hawk Hollow







Bond Series 2024 - Sale Summary





- Par Amount = \$57, 230,000
- Net Proceeds = \$62,354,666.49
- During the order period, the Series 2024 bonds received over half a billion dollars in orders resulting in 8.87x oversubscription.
- In total, 28 different institutional accounts placed orders for the bonds
- \$915,000 of individual retail participation in Illinois with \$390,000 directly from district residents

Bond Series 2024 - Commitment to Community



UNDERWRITING

 Cabrera Capital, a Minority Business Enterprise (MBE), served as Co-Manager with a 25% liability equating to over \$14M of the Series 2024 Bonds

INVESTORS

•\$545,000 of bonds were purchased by Garcia Hamilton, an MBE investment management firm

LOCAL COMMUNITY

- Leading up to the sale, the District hosted an investor presentation for its community members to learn about purchasing the Series 2024 Bonds
- •Ultimately, \$390,000 of bonds were sold to local investors within the District
