Senior guard Troyer Carlson averaged 22.3 points for Kaneland in wins over LaSalle-Peru, Plano and

Johnsburg, moving up to sixth on the Knights' all-time scoring list with 1,187 points. He passed Doug Lakin, who had 1,185, and trails Chuck Turk for fifth place by 58.
