U-46 waiving several fees for 2022-23 school year

As it did for this school year, School District U-46 will be waiving most fees for the 2022-23 school year because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Among those included are registration fees for kindergarten through 6th-grade students and instructional materials fees and ChromeBook repair insurance for middle and high school students.

The fee to participate in middle school athletics will be \$80 per sport.

High school athletic fees will be \$150 per sport and \$200 for football, with a maximum of two high school sports fees per school year and family maximum of four sports fees per year at the high school level. The fee to take part in other afterschool activities will be \$40.

Optional high school fees will include \$250 for behind-the-wheel driver's education and \$13 for a driver's ed textbook; \$45.75 to take a lifeguard training course; \$15 to take an independent PE course; and \$45 for a basic yearbook.
