- Strengthen support for student transitions and college/career pathways.

Title I: Early learning, literacy specialists, professional learning, intervention supports.

Title II: Instructional coaching model, support for ongoing, job-embedded learning, Instructional Empowerment, AVID, Visible Learning.

Title III: Multilingual materials, teacher training, Bilingual/ESL endorsement support, family engagement.

Title IV: Social-emotional learning supports, college and career planning, technology, elevating student voice.

IDEA: Coordinated early intervening services, supplemental curriculum and resources, equipment, assistive technology, professional learning.
