A single, comprehensive plan aligned to federal, state, and local priorities.

Required by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA).

Not a grant application, but a strategy document.

Involves collaboration across departments and stakeholder input.

#### Needs Assessment Highlights

- Need to strengthen foundational literacy and numeracy (K-3)
- Address disproportionate discipline and referrals for special education.
- Comprehensive professional learning to ensure trauma-informed practices are implemented and student social emotional learning needs are met.
- Need to strengthen multilingual and newcomer services.
- Strengthen support for student transitions and college/career pathways.

# **Aligned Strategies**



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**Title I:** Early learning, literacy specialists, professional learning, intervention supports.

**Title II:** Instructional coaching model, support for ongoing, job-embedded learning, Instructional Empowerment, AVID, Visible Learning.

**Title III:** Multilingual materials, teacher training, Bilingual/ESL endorsement support, family engagement.

**Title IV:** Social-emotional learning supports, college and career planning, technology, elevating student voice.

**IDEA:** Coordinated early intervening services, supplemental curriculum and resources, equipment, assistive technology, professional learning.
