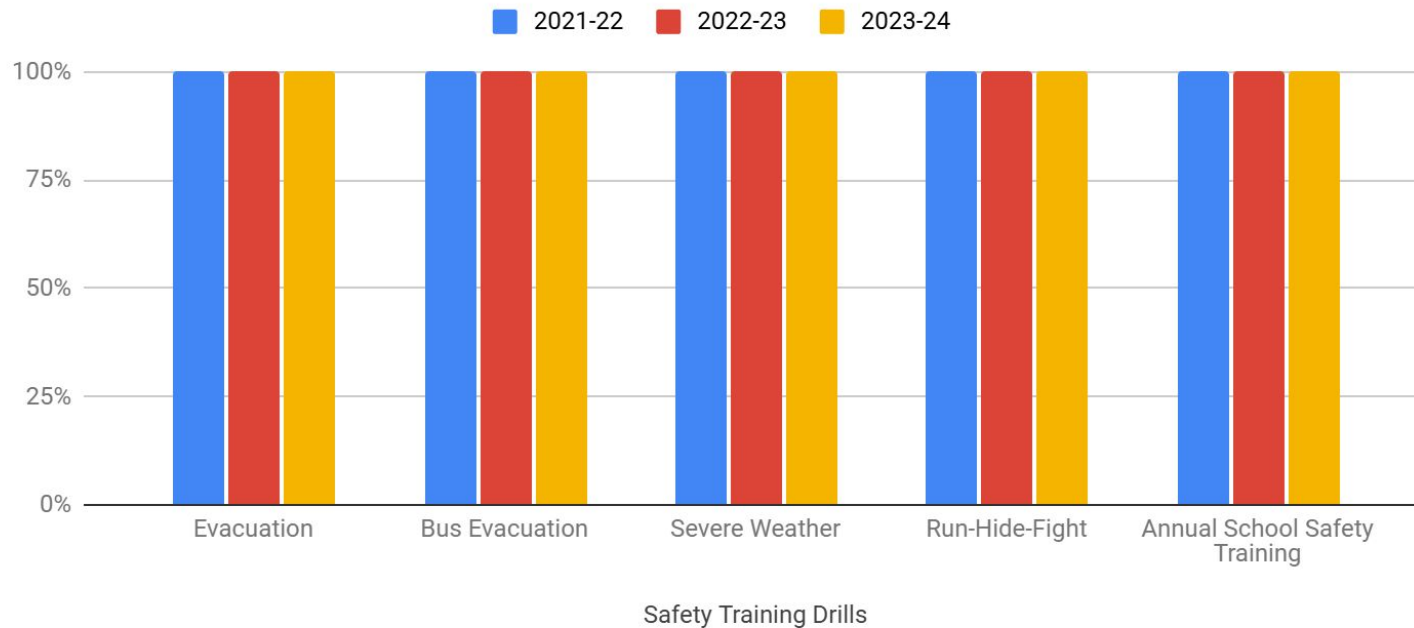
District Safety Mission Statement

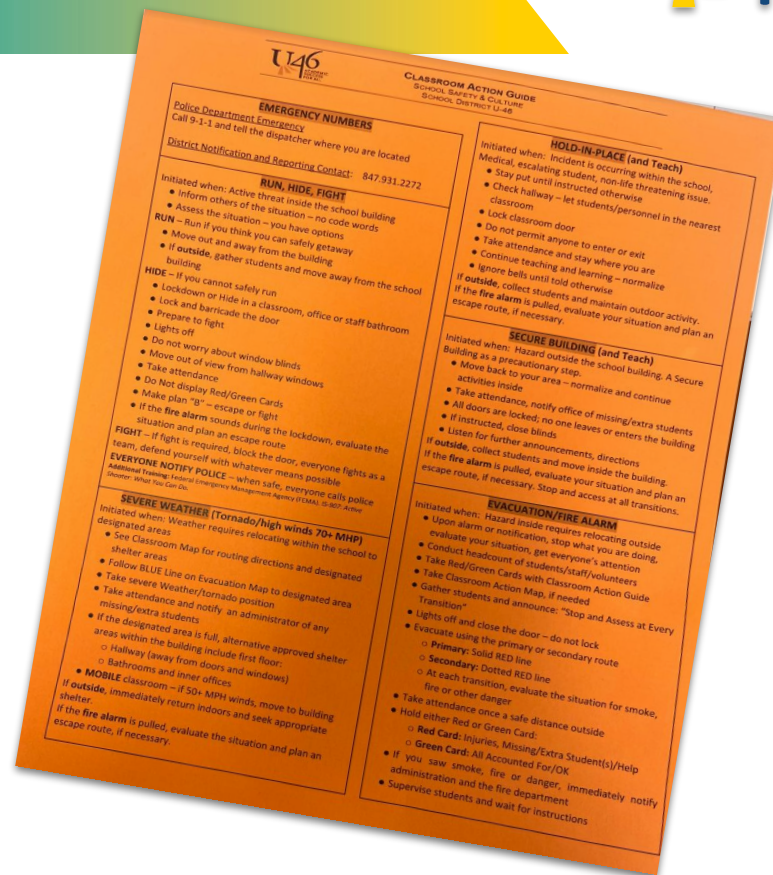

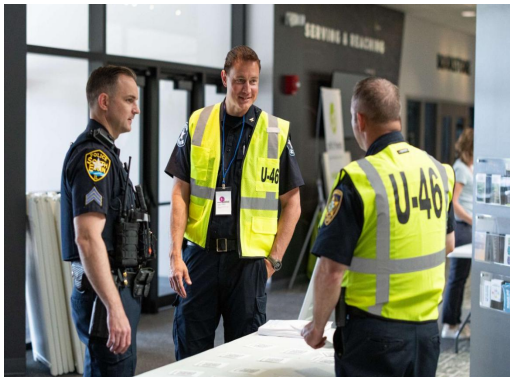
Kane County Regional Office of Education (ROE) and 9 districts that incorporate the county developed a training cohort to train nearly 300 administrators on the Reunification Process.

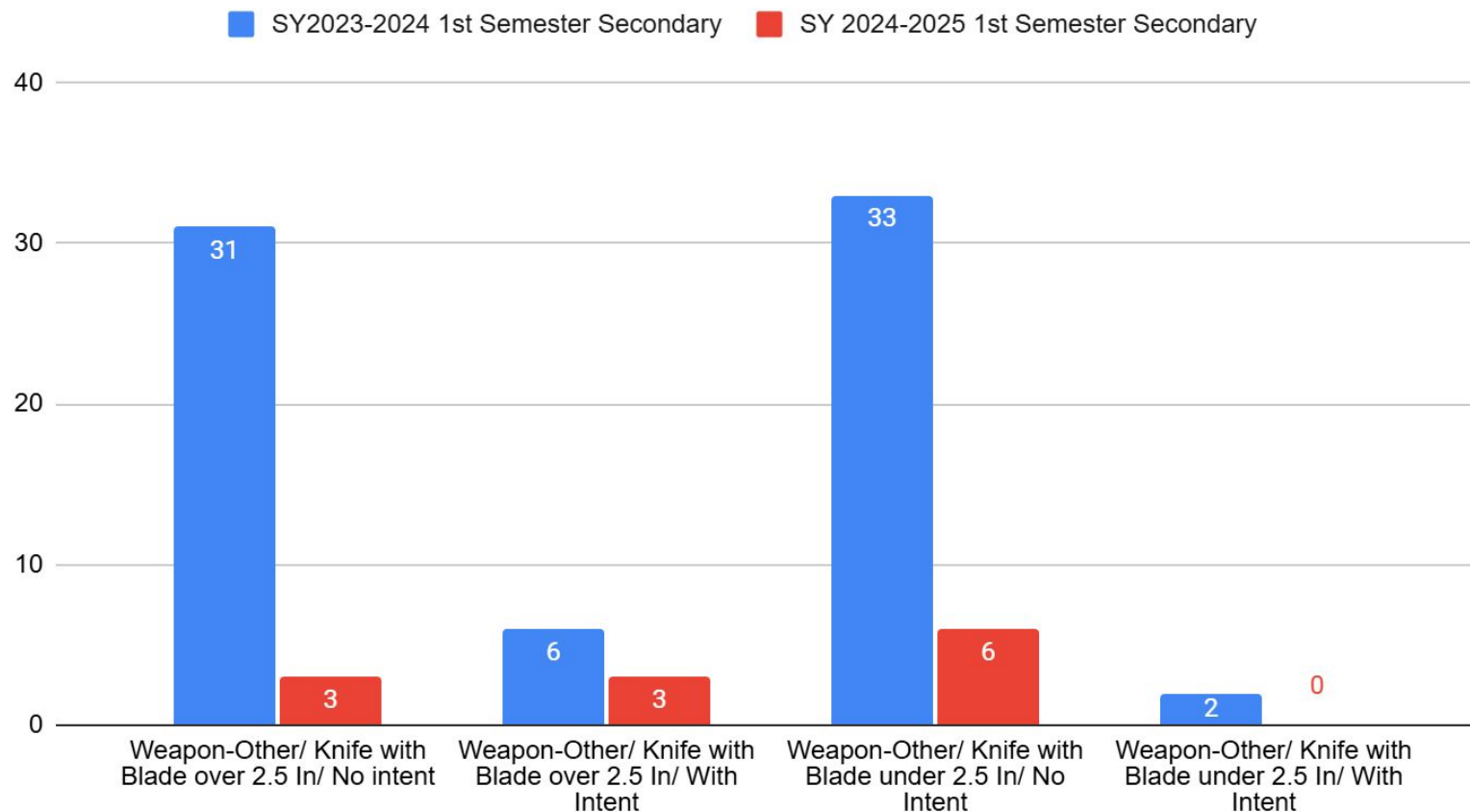
