- Assign custom weights to individual pieces of data to reflect our vision and values

- Focused on Reading and Math

- Approximately half of the weighting can be measured in Spanish

Key Features

- All measurements will be converted to a common 1-10 scale
- 19 / 28 measurements extend beyond only reporting reading and math scores
 - Yet proficiency, growth in reading, math still represent 50% of the overall calculation
- Elementary and High School are equally weighted
- Composite metrics will be independent. See Example →

- What sentiment and values drive the rating of a 1-10?
 - For example, is a score of 5 equivalent to the state/national average or is a 7?
 - What result is needed to receive a score of 10?
 - The values and sentiments associated with each rating will then be used to determine how each piece of data will be evaluated
