Student Handbook

As a new school year gets underway, it's important for parents and guardians to talk to their children about expectations and consequences around issues of safety at school.

Parents and guardians should review the <u>Student Handbook</u> and the <u>Code of Conduct</u> with their child. Parents and guardians should also be aware of their children's social media activity, and remind them that no weapons are allowed on school grounds, including lookalike weapons.

In addition, please remind your child about the importance of "see something, say something." If they have any safety or security concerns, they should speak about them immediately to their teacher, principal, or another trusted adult. U-46 and our local law enforcement partners take all safety concerns to schools very seriously. Intentional disruptions to the safety of the school will face serious school consequences according to the <u>Student Code of Conduct</u>, and criminal charges when appropriate. According to the <u>Illinois Criminal Statutes</u>, potential criminal charges for intentional school safety threats may include felony charges.

Working together, we will continue to keep our schools safe learning environments for all our students and staff.

Stay Connected


Now that the school year is underway, family and community members have a variety of ways they can stay connected to School District U-46:

This past Tuesday, Aug. 20, was the first day of preschool for our youngest learners. U-46 welcomed preschool students to classrooms at Illinois Park Center for Early Learning, Independence Center for Early Learning, Larkin High School, and 10 elementary schools. U-46 now has the capacity to educate about 1,650 preschool students, about 270 more than just two years ago, partially thanks to the work of <u>Unite U-46</u>.
