Spring Recess

U-46's spring recess will begin on Monday, March 25, and last through Monday, April 1. After that, classes for students are scheduled through Thursday, May 30, which is the last day for students if no additional emergency days are used. Remember that May 3 is now a student attendance day.

When classes are in session, it's extremely important that our students are in school and on time to class every day, for the entire school day.

Each day in school counts and helps build the foundation for your child's academic success. It is an important opportunity for students to learn as well as collaborate with their peers on rigorous, standards-aligned tasks that require critical thinking, collaboration, creativity, and communication. When your child is absent, they miss out on this collaboration.



We hope you plan your Spring Recess vacation in time for your child(ren) to return to school on Tuesday, April 2. We'll look forward to seeing them back in class!

Eclipse Permission Slip

The permission slip to allow your student to safely view the eclipse on Monday, April 8, is now available here. Use your Infinite Campus credentials to log in and get access to the permission slip. You'll then see a waiver with the names of all of your children who are in U-46 schools. Next to each name will be a drop-down menu that will allow you to choose "yes" or "no" granting permission. The online slip must be signed before midnight on Wednesday, April 3.



Students whose parents have signed the slip - and whose teacher has completed the necessary professional development - will be provided eclipse glasses or an eclipse viewer in class on Monday, April 8.

The U-46 Planetarium is continuing to host special public sky shows focused on the eclipse. Admission is free for these shows, but seating is limited and offered on a first-come, first-served basis. Doors open at 4 p.m. on these dates, and the hour-long shows are being offered on:

- Thursday, March 21, at 4:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m.
- Tuesday, April 2, at 4:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m.

5Essentials Closes Soon

Can you set aside 15 minutes this week to help make a difference in your children's schools? That's all it will take to complete the <u>5Essentials Survey</u>, a research-based survey that provides a unique opportunity for teachers, students, and parents to have a voice in improving our schools.



Organizing Schools for Improvement

This survey generates reports to help drive school improvement on the five leading indicators or "essentials" – effective leaders, collaborative teachers, involved families, supportive environment, and ambitious instruction. Schools in U-46 use this valuable feedback to make changes and create new programs. For instance, at one elementary school, the survey's results led to more afterschool offerings and a 6th grade parent panel to support students transitioning to middle school.

However, data from the parent survey will be made available to the school only if at least 20 percent of parents at the school respond. So don't delay! The survey closes on Friday, March 29. Click here to get started.

STEM Expo

Students have the opportunity to showcase their passion for science, technology, engineering, and/or mathematics at the 2024 STEM Expo!

Registration for the annual Expo is free, and the event is open to all students in kindergarten through 12th grade. Students develop a



question or problem they would like to solve and explore it through hands-on investigation and research. Students then plan, carry out, and present their projects to fellow students, families, and community members at the Expo.

If your child needs some inspiration for a project, they can watch the STEM Expo Kick-Off events, which were held virtually last fall, on the U-46 Science and Planetarium <u>YouTube channel</u>. In addition, the department's <u>Facebook page</u> might prompt some ideas, as well!



If you have a child who will be entering kindergarten, 6th grade, 9th grade, or 12th grade next school year, the state of Illinois has certain health requirements for those students. For incoming seniors, that means proving they are up to date on their meningococcal vaccine. For students in the other listed grades, physical exams and certain immunizations are required.

You can find details on the requirements, as well as the necessary forms, in English and Spanish on this page, in the Health Services section of the U-46 website. Forms are due on or before Aug. 13.

Because of these required physicals, summers are always busy at the offices of pediatricians. Please schedule your doctor's appointments now! Families who have questions or need assistance locating a clinic for a physical or immunization should contact the nurse at their school.
