Measles Update

According to the Illinois Department of Public Health, Illinois is currently experiencing an outbreak of measles among adults and children, with most cases concentrated in northeast Illinois in Cook, Will, and Lake counties.

Measles is highly contagious, especially in school-aged children. U-46, which works closely with our local Departments of Public Health, has not had any confirmed positive cases. The U-46 Health Services Department is cautiously monitoring all trends and information, and nursing staff at each school building are watching for illness signs and symptoms that may be consistent with measles.

To prevent the spread of infection, it is critical that staff and students have the age-appropriate number of doses of measles, mumps, rubella (MMR) vaccine, or other evidence of immunity to measles.
