FINAL Dual Credit Info Session

The final informational session about the full-time [Dual Credit program](#) is being held virtually Thursday, Oct. 26, at 6 p.m. Current sophomores and juniors are eligible to apply for the program for the 2024-25 school year. Participants take all of their coursework at Elgin Community College (ECC) while earning both high school and college credit for their courses, saving students thousands of dollars in college tuition. The session is being offered via Zoom and can be joined [here](#). The presentation will be in English with interpretation in Spanish.



Magnet Academy Deadline

Current 8th grade students interested in attending one of the District's five Magnet Academies in high school must submit their application by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, Oct. 31. To be considered for a U-46 Magnet Academy, students are required to have a 2.0 GPA and two letters of recommendation.
