We love seeing our students every day at school, especially as we near the holiday season and the end of 2022. Please remember that it is extremely important that our students are in school and on time to class every day, right up until the end of the school day.

Every day in school counts and helps build the foundation for your child's academic success. It is an important opportunity for students to learn as well as collaborate with their peers on rigorous, standards-aligned tasks that require critical thinking, collaboration, creativity, and communication. When your child is absent, they miss out on this collaboration.

Extended absences and/or vacations during the school year are discouraged and considered unexcused absences. The only approved vacation periods for U-46 occur during Thanksgiving and

winter recess, spring break, and summer vacation. Thank you, as always, for your support and cooperation.

- <u>Building Substitute Teacher</u>: The substitute teachers implement instructional plans in the absence of the classroom teacher. They serve as a positive role model for students. Building

substitutes are assigned in one building for the duration of the school year.
