#### Unite U-46

Community chairs for the <u>Unite U-46</u> initiative delivered their recommendations to the U-46 Board of Education on Monday night. The meeting can be viewed on the District's YouTube channel at <u>youtube.com/user/SchoolDistrictU46</u> or by clicking on the video below.



As a reminder, Unite U-46 is a community engagement initiative that seeks to develop recommendations on the best way to implement the long-range vision of the U-46 Board of Education; this vision includes shifting middle school to include grades 6th, 7th, and 8th (the current model has 6th grade as part of elementary school); using the space in elementary schools to expand early childhood opportunities across U-46; and to replace and/or renovate some of the

District's older buildings to provide equitable access to learning environments that support academic success for all.

The U-46 Board of Education is holding a special meeting at 7 p.m. on Monday, Dec. 19, to consider the committee's recommendations. That meeting can also be viewed on the District's <u>YouTube channel</u>; a limited number of seats will be available in the Board room at 355 E. Chicago St., Elgin.
