- The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's <u>2023 Poster, Poetry, and Essay Contest</u>. Deadline for entries is Feb. 1, 2023.

College Scholarships

For high school seniors, now is the time to start thinking about college scholarships, and winter break is the perfect opportunity to begin drafting some possible essay ideas.

In January, the <u>U-46 Educational Foundation</u> will share information on the dozen scholarships it manages, along with the online scholarship application students can use to apply for them. In the meantime, here are two things seniors can do over the break to prepare for this application and other scholarship applications offered outside of the U-46 Educational Foundation.

- 1. Start thinking about a school "resume." Make a list of all extracurricular activities, volunteer activities, and any paid employment. Include any leadership roles and all awards received.
- 2. For all scholarships using the Foundation's Online Scholarship Application, an essay explaining why you should be chosen for a scholarship will need to be included. But a version of the question is a common one on all scholarship applications. Seniors should consider taking time over winter break to begin drafting some essay ideas.
