Students will not have classes on Tuesday, April 4. It's Election Day, and a number of U-46 schools are used as polling places.

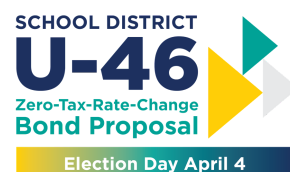
There will also be no classes on Friday, April 7, for the Spring Holiday. U-46 offices and buildings will also be closed on April 7.
