### Rumba Meats Scholarship:

\* Must be a high school senior graduating in the Spring of 2021 with minimum GPA 2.5

\* Applicants must be enrolled or accepted in an accredited four or two year institution in the U.S.

\* Students must verify their enrollment status for the 2021-2022 academic school year prior to scholarship disbursement

\* NON-U.S. Citizens are eligible to apply (DACA or undocumented)

\* Applicants must demonstrate a verifiable need for financial support

\* Consistent, active participation in public and/or community service activities \* At least one parent must be of Hispanic ancestry
