On Monday, November 16 the Kane County Health Department provided guidance that U-46 take an “adaptive pause,” effective Monday, Nov 23 and extending through Friday, Dec. 4. An adaptive pause under the state’s COVID-19 mitigation plans means that all students return to distance learning while there is a substantial transmission of cases in a region. This means all students will remain or return to a strictly distance learning format from Nov. 23 through at least Dec. 4.
