ARMED SERVICES VOCATIONAL APTITUDE BATTERY (ASVAB) TEST

South Elgin High School will offer the ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) Career Exploration Program (CEP) Assessment for Sophomore, Junior, and Senior students. The ASVAB is a standardized exam and will take approximately 3 hours to complete. The testing will begin at 3:30 p.m. on Wednesday, January 27th, and there is no charge to take it. The test will take place at South Elgin High School. Students who would like to sign up to take this exam should complete the registration form by Wednesday, January 20th.
