Refund Policy: If a student withdraws prior to the first day of school we will provide a full refund of all fees. If the withdrawal occurs after the first day of classes no refund will be provided.

Partial Year Instructional Fee: If a new student enters the District between the first day of classes in August and December 31, the full **Regular** registration fee listed above will be due. New students registering after January 1 will be required to pay 50% of the **Regular** registration fee listed above.

On-line Payment: Parents and/or guardians will have the option to pay on-line using a credit card, checking or savings account number. The District will waive the on-line processing fee.
