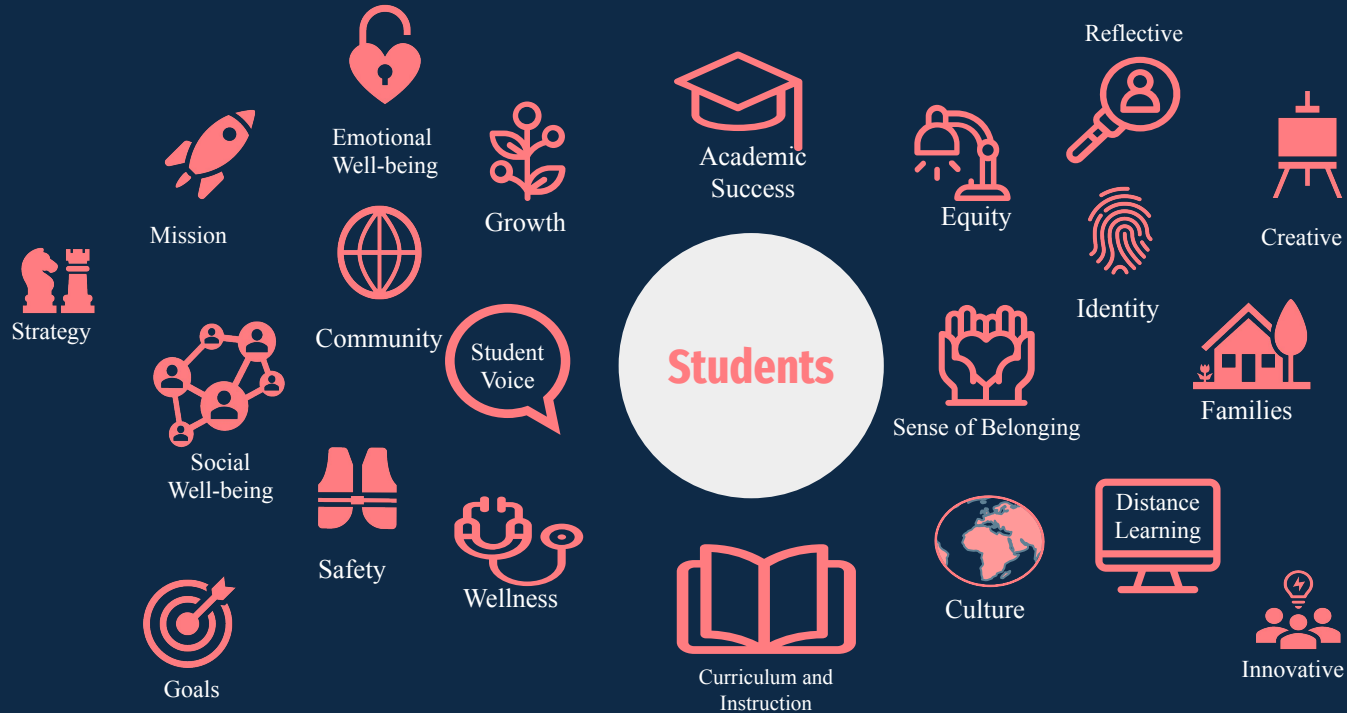

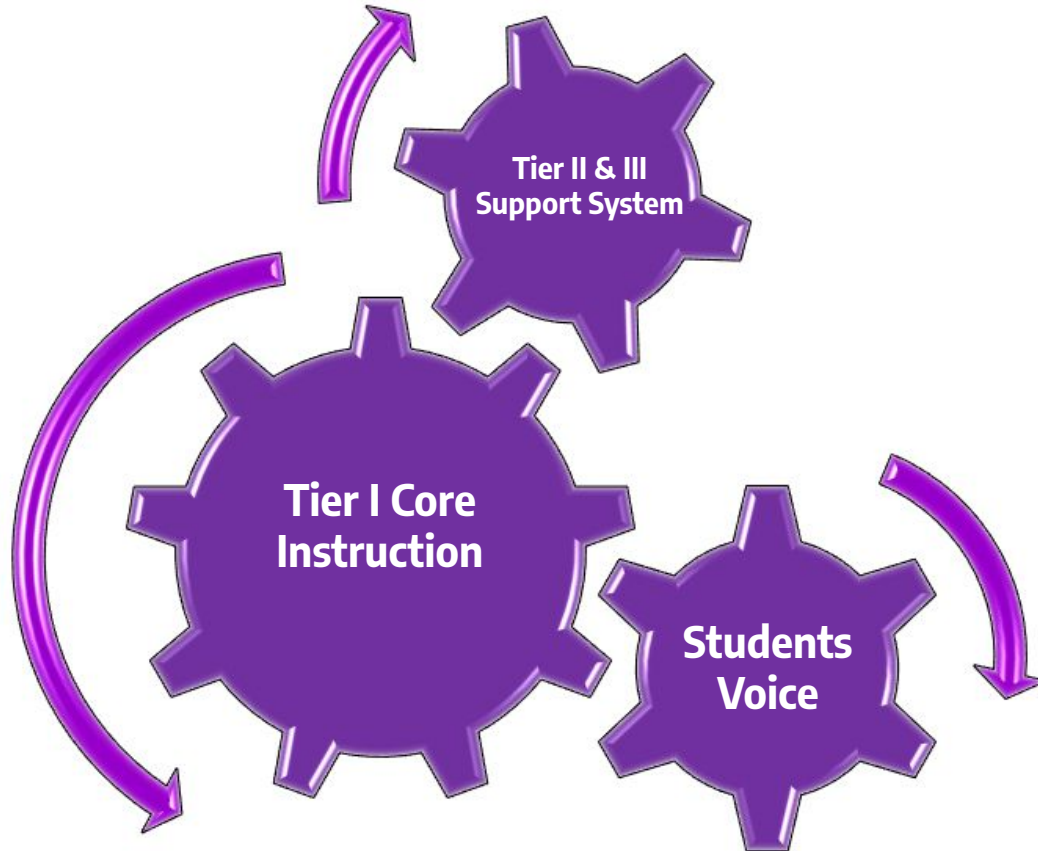

Freshman Success**

Situation

- Correlation between freshmen year and graduation rate
- Ensure a smooth transition from middle school to high school (relationships/process)
- SY 18-19 FOT (Freshmen on Track) 81%
- Freshmen on Track are four times as likely to graduate than their off-track freshmen peers (University of Chicago)

Action

- SHS Targeted Universalism Tool
- Freshmen Success Leadership Committee (students, teachers, administration)
- Freshmen Success Advisory Board (student-driven)
- Freshmen mentors
- Freshmen Success Learning Team (executive functioning mini-lessons)
- Academic-behavioral-social emotional needs reviewed at Problem Solving Team for all freshmen
- Freshmen tutoring
- Freshmen 4-year plan
- On track reflection tool

Results

- Increase from 81% to 86% in Freshmen on Track for SY 19-20
- Increase from 71% Quarter 1 to 82.5% by Semester end SY 20-21
- Attendance (94.3%) highest attending
