Dear Liberty Families,

Our 3rd - 6th grade students will complete the PARCC state test next month. The testing window for this assessment runs from April 4 - April 29. This year our 3rd graders will complete a paper version of the test while 4th - 6th graders will complete the test online.

For those of you that are new to this testing, the PARCC test is aligned with our new Illinois Learning Standards. It helps to give teachers, families and students a more accurate measure of how well Illinois students are performing compared to other students across the country and whether they're on track to succeed in college. The PARCC assessment will also more closely track student learning so that any necessary remediation can take place as students progress through elementary and high school.

Students will complete tests in language arts that will demonstrate:

- Whether students can read and comprehend texts of varying complexities
- How well students can integrate information across sources to make a persuasive argument
- The degree to which students can use context to determine the meaning of academic vocabulary

Students will also complete math tests that will demonstrate:

- Whether students understand and can use important math ideas, including number sense, algebraic thinking, geometry and data analysis
- The extent to which students can use math facts and reasoning skills to solve realworld problems
- How well students can make math arguments

As the testing window approaches, classroom teachers will share more information regarding specific testing dates and times for your child's class.
