There were lots of emotional moments at a ceremony earlier this month honoring the student winners in the 2022-23 Voces del Corazón/Voices from the Heart Writing & Art Contest.

Voces del Corazón is designed to nurture creative expression and to validate the diverse identities of all U-46 Dual Language and ESL students.

Earlier in the school year, Dual Language and ESL students from across U-46's elementary, middle and high schools were challenged to write essays for the contest about the value of bilingualism and judged by volunteers at the school and district-level. All first-place winners received a certificate congratulating their work, and four schools won an original mural designed by U-46 Dual Language students.

The final meeting for this school year of the <u>Bilingual Parent Advisory Committee</u> (BPAC) is Wednesday, May 17, at 6 p.m., with both an in-person and virtual option available. #U46Classof2023 Graduation Ceremonies

Graduation ceremonies for the <u>Class of 2023</u> will be held on Saturday, May 27, 2023, at the NOW Arena, 5333 Prairie Stone Parkway, Hoffman Estates. The first ceremony is Larkin High School at 8 a.m., followed by Streamwood High School at 11 a.m., South Elgin High School at 2 p.m., Elgin High School at 5 p.m., and Bartlett High School wrapping up the evening with a ceremony starting at 8 p.m.



To make this special event run smoothly, guests are asked not to bring large bags, purses, noise makers, or balloons into the NOW Arena. NOW Arena security will conduct bag searches and use hand-held metal detector wands for random checks of guests. Also, NOW Arena security staff will require all graduates to walk through metal detectors at the student entrance.

Graduates, families, and guests are asked to arrive 45 minutes prior to the graduation ceremony. To reduce parking and traffic problems, groups are asked to ride in the fewest possible number of vehicles. After the ceremony, families are encouraged to head to their cars after about 30 minutes in the meet and greet area. IMPORTANT NOTE: On Friday, May 26, all high school students, other than students in Transition programs, will be dismissed early at 1:40 p.m. to allow seniors to participate in graduation practice. The buses will follow their usual schedule, and we will provide supervision for students who need to wait at the school for the bus. Students in Transition programs at our high schools will be dismissed at their regular time.
