This application requires phone permission so that it can retrieve the serial number of the device.

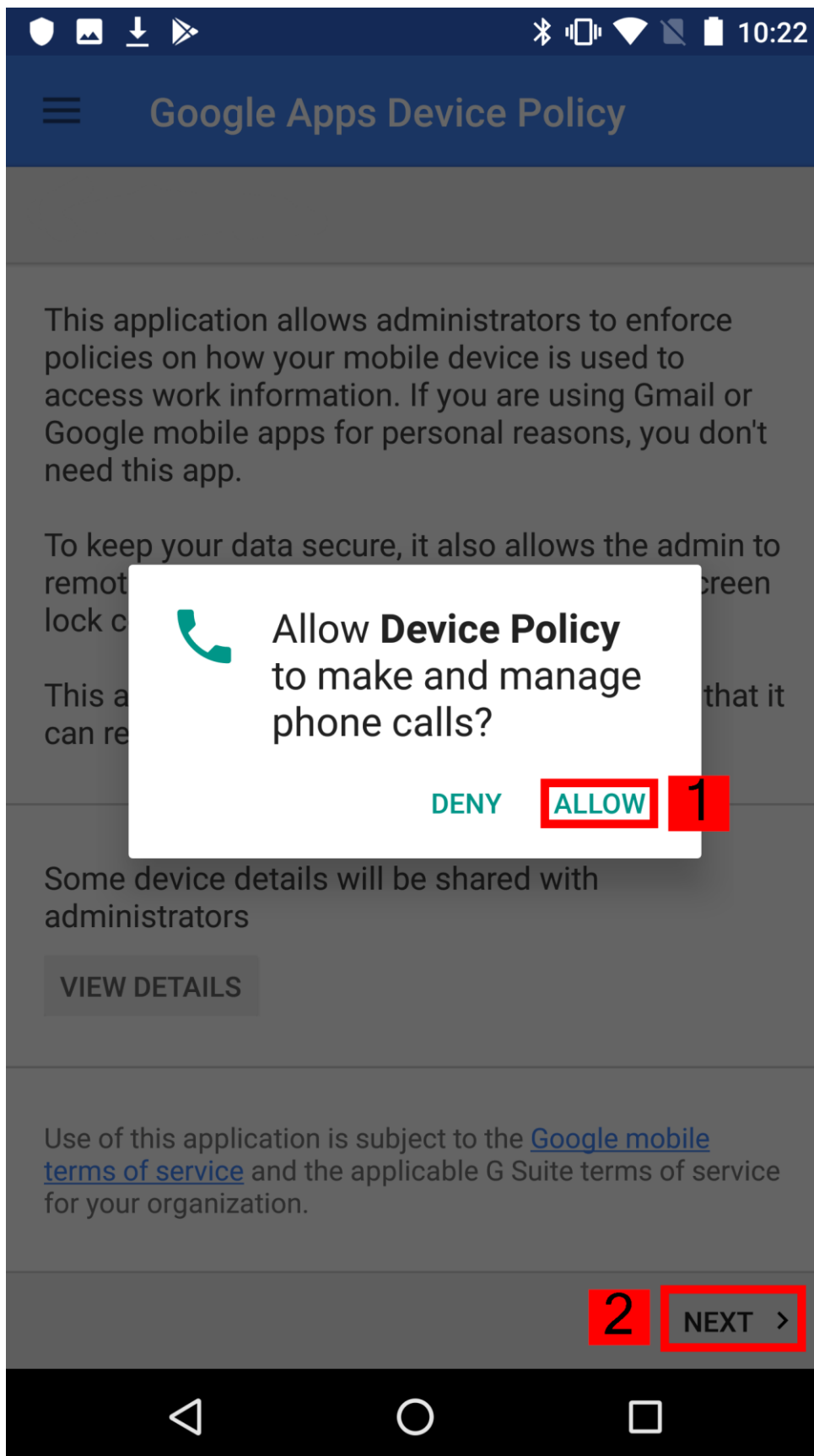
