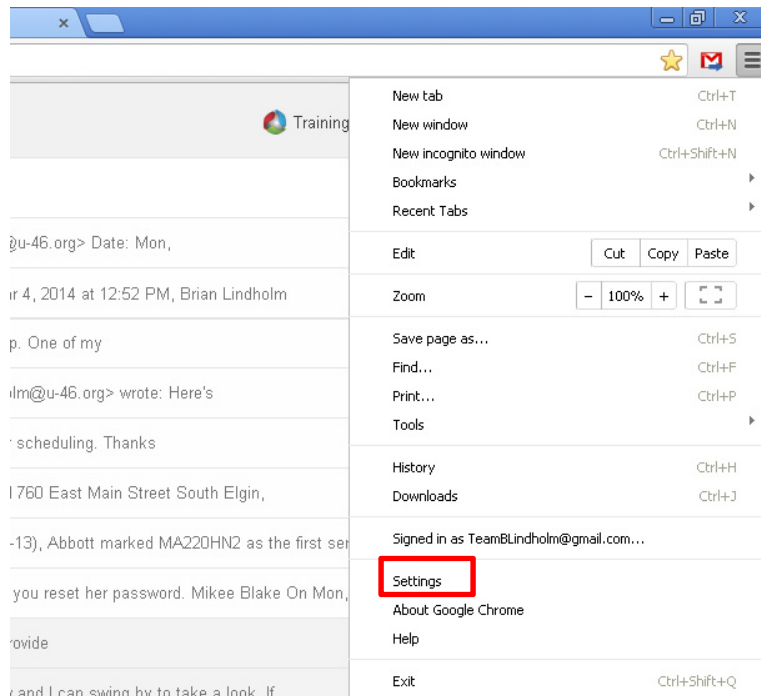
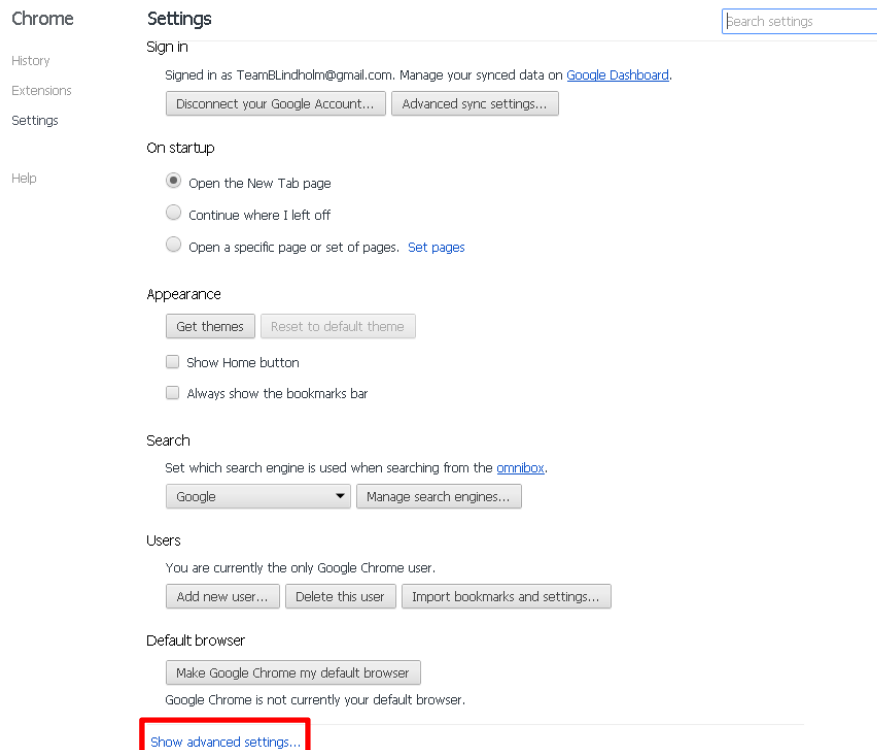


Changing your Download Directory in Google Chrome

1. Click on the Google Chrome settings icon in the top-right corner, select Settings



2. Click “Show advanced settings” at the bottom of the page to see more options



- Under “Downloads”, click “Change” to establish where you’d like your downloads to be saved. I’d also suggest clicking “Ask where to save each file before downloading” – as this provides a good reminder each time you download of where the file is being saved.
